Subject: Patterson Pass Road & Tesla Road Safety Study, Livermore, Alameda County

On March 27, 2013, Alameda County Public Works Agency held a community meeting regarding the proposed roadway safety studies for Patterson Pass Road and Tesla Road in the unincorporated Livermore area. The purpose of these studies is to identify and prioritize safety improvement needs along these two roadways between Greenville Road and the County line. The Agency received information from residents and roadway users, and will be incorporating community feedback into the studies.

During the meeting, staff emphasized that there are no plans to widen any of these roadways, and the focus of these studies was to ensure safety for the traveling public. I want to again reiterate that there are no plans to widen Patterson Pass Road or Tesla Road.

The Agency will continue to notify residents of upcoming meetings, and continue to post project and construction related information on our website ([www.acpwa.org](http://www.acpwa.org)). Your comments concerning these roadways are important to our studies, and we urge you to continue to participate in any way possible.

Also, in the next few days, you will begin to see preparatory work for the resurfacing of Tesla Road between South Livermore Avenue and Cross Road. This work is a part of regularly scheduled pavement maintenance to overlay Tesla Road with asphalt, prolonging the life of the road and improving ride quality.
